Measures and precautions

In compliance with the regulations of the Corona Protection Ordinance, we have defined the following measures and precautions for our guided city tours:

Ticket purchase

Tickets must be purchased in advance online, via our booking hotline or at the Tourist Information Office (please note opening hours).

A spontaneous ticket purchase from the tour guide is not possible!



Limited group size

The number of participants for our guided city tours is generally limited to a maximum of 20 guests per group.



Hygiene requirements and current regulations

- Be sure to wash and disinfect your hands regularly and thoroughly.
- Observe the correct etiquette when coughing and sneezing (into the crook of your arm).
- Keep a distance of at least 1.5 metres to other people.
- Stay home if you have (cold) symptoms to avoid endangering others.



Mask regulations

If masks are compulsory, a medical face mask (at least a so-called surgical mask) must always be worn (unless otherwise regulated locally). It is not usually required outdoors, but it is required indoors, on buses and in queues.

2G

2G (vaccinated or recovered)

For all our guided tours visitors must be fully vaccinated or have recovered from Covid-19. You will need one of the following two proofs, which will be checked on site by the tour guide:

- **Vaccinated:** Proof of vaccination, stating that the 2nd vaccination was given at least 14 days ago.
- **Recovered:** Proof of a positive PCR test result that is at least 28 days old and not older than 6 months.

Please note that it is not possible to take part in a guided tour without 2G proof.

Exptions to the 2G rule:

- children and teenager up to 15 years
- Persons who have a medical certificate stating that they cannot be vaccinated against Covid for health reasons at present or up to a point in time that is no more than six weeks ago. These persons must present a negative test result (rapid antigen test, not older than 24h or PCR test, not older than 48h).
